

# Presidents and Their First Ladies, Dramatically Speaking: Abraham and Mary Todd Lincoln



Before becoming the 16th American President in 1861, Abraham Lincoln was the son of a Kentucky frontiersman, struggling for a living and for learning. Lincoln went on to be instrumental in building the Republican Party into a strong national organization and his strong disdain for inequality resulted in the issue of his famous Emancipation Proclamation, declaring the abolishment of slavery. With the country in the throes of a four-year civil war, Lincoln won re-election, displaying flexibility and generosity while planning for a peaceful reconstruction of the United States.

Tragically, Lincoln was assassinated before ever witnessing a reunited union. By his side throughout his presidency was his wife, Mary Todd. Both suffered the early passing of their mothers but were opposite in background, physical stature, and temperament. Nevertheless, they were united by an enduring love - by Mary's confidence in her husband's abilities and his gentle consideration of her excitable ways.

The story of Abraham and Mary Todd Lincoln's time in the White House is brought to life by the veteran husband and wife acting duo, William and Sue Wills. Their engaging performance is recommended for American History buffs, students, or any fan of a great story.




