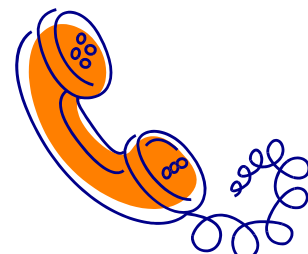

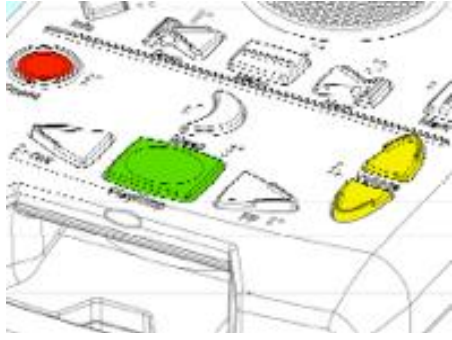
TB: What's some of your favorite books?

TO READ CARTRIDGES WITH MULTIPLE BOOKS GO TO "BOOKSHELF" MODE

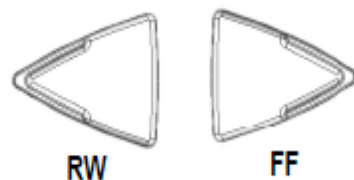
1. Insert cartridge in player
